

SLP Track/Hifax Anti-Wear Pads

CONTENTS:

1/4" x .080 flat washer 1/4" x 3/4" Contoured bolt (Anti-wear Pad) 1/4" nylock nut *One of the above for every closed window

TOOLS REQUIRED:

Channel Lock Pliers or Vise Grips 7/16" Socket
Drill
1/4" Track Drill
(SLP Part # 20-160)

*Note: Installation is easiest if the back of the sled is lifted 2 to 3' in the air.

- 1. Drilling holes from the back of the sled, Center 1/4" track drill (20-160) on the center of the star in the window or the center of the closed window. Every closed window must have an anti-wear pad installed.
- 2. Rotate the track upward to gain access to install anti-wear pad bolts.
- 3. Install anti-wear pad bolts from the inside of the track with the bolt threads to the outside.
- 4. Install washers and nylock nut on the outside of the track.
- 5. While tightening the nylock nut, hold the anti-wear pad with a pair of channel lock pliers or vise grips just until the anti-wear pad will hold itself from turning.
- 6. Tighten nylock nuts only until the rubber begins to deform at the edge of the washer or the anti-wear pad.

*Note: If you are concaving the washer then you are over tightening.

7. Periodically check to make sure the nuts are properly secured and you are not missing any anti-wear pads.
